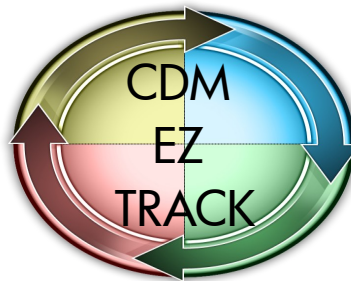

TEXAS STATE DSH STATUS - 2010

CampbellWilson has been working with our clients, HHSC and managed care organizations the past few weeks to resolve data processing issues we identified during our review of hospital claims for the 2010 state DSH year determination. Throughout these many weeks, there have been meetings and communications to discuss the data issues that could potentially impact a hospital's DSH days, and particularly the Medicaid Shortfall calculation.

As a result, several changes are being made to claims reports which should be re-issued shortly by TMHP and several managed care plans. The changes made will more accurately report charge, payment and day data that potentially impact a hospital's Medicaid CAP calculation, UPL and DSH determinations.

TEXAS STATE DSH AUDIT STATUS – 2005-2007

The State DSH audits have been kicked-off by Clifton Gunderson, the State DSH Audit contractor, and HHSC in the past few weeks at various locations throughout Texas. All hospitals should have gotten notification of the type of audit that will apply; on-site, enhanced, or other. The list of data items requested for the Audit is fairly extensive and may present some challenges as the data required is for data years 2005-2007.

The deadline for submission of data is April 9, 2010. CampbellWilson is assisting our clients with gathering the information requested by Clifton Gunderson.

TEXAS STATE DSH – 2011

Although State DSH 2010 is not complete, the State DSH 2011 claims reconciliation process is almost upon us. 2011 is the first year where the subsequent audit may result in over/under adjustments, similar to Medicare and Medicaid cost report adjustments. There will be no appeals process to change data reported in the Annual Survey or Community Benefits Report. Also of note is that HHSC has changed (clarified) the rules for the data to be reported as uninsured, as well as other data that impacts the Medicaid DSH and shortfall calculation. Hospitals should be aware of these changes and potential impact subsequently on their DSH, UPL financial reporting and budgeting processes. It is critical that hospitals evaluate their processes for report data impacting the State DSH determination and implement changes to manage claims adjudication and potential over/underpayments for Medicaid State DSH interim determinations and UPL going forward.
